### Experiential Education Programs Manager

Seattle Tilth is an environmental education organization that seeks to inspire and educate people to safeguard our natural resources while building an equitable and sustainable local food system. Our experiential education programs are key to that work. Our children's education programs offer opportunities for children to connect with their environment and learn where food comes from through fieldtrips, immersive summer camp experiences, teacher trainings, and more. Our adult education programs allow people to take action in their own lives by providing hands-on education and workshops covering topics such as growing organic fruits and vegetables, building healthy soil, raising backyard livestock, preserving the harvest, and various resource conservation topics.



The Experiential Education Program Manager is primarily responsible for all aspects of the adult and children's education programs, including managing program budget and work plan, supervising staff, developing, scheduling and teaching classes and workshops, and documenting and standardizing curriculum across Seattle Tilth. While Seattle Tilth has a long and respected history of providing educational opportunities, we believe in the importance of continually improving and enhancing what we offer. A key part of the Experiential Education Program Manager's role will be to explore and develop new and innovative opportunities to expand and strengthen our reach to both children and adults.

The successful applicant will be a creative, self-motivated individual with an enthusiasm for environmental education who is equally at ease in front of a group or behind the scenes crunching numbers and getting the details right. A history of program management and/or teaching is important, as is demonstrated experience using organic gardening methods.
